Stelios Mousarris, a Cypriot conceptual designer, presents The Wave City table which has transformed the intricate details of the cityscape into functional design using 3D printing technology. Dubai is flipped upside-down and the precision of each building is shown in stark contrast to the sleek, smooth shape of the tabletop.

Tarek El Kassouf, Fractures



Lebanese architect, designer and urban planner Tarek El Kassouf has created a series of abstract lights called Intersect, Lean and Fracture constructed in brass and steel that take inspiration from the urban environment and display his industrial, futuristic style.
